- Second priority** A child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both Satisfy, the work/training/study test under section 14 of the Family Assistance Legislation
- Third priority -** any other child

Within each category\* mentioned above the following children are to be given priority:

- Children in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families
- Children in families which include a disabled person
- Children in families whose CCB percentage is 100%
- Children in families with a non-English speaking background
- Children in socially isolated families
- Children of single parents

\*the above list is not in any particular priority order and children may fall into more than one category\*

There is a possibility that families in the third priority category may need to vacate their place should a child in a higher priority category need care. Two weeks' notice of this would be given by the service.
